



Terms & Conditions

Wetskills-The Netherlands 2017

The participant declares by registration that:

- He/she is able to attend the Wetskills Water Challenge programme in The Netherlands during the period of 19 October to 2 November 2017.
- He/she is able to pay the programme fee of maximum *€ 450,- (or *€ 25,- discount for early bird registration before 15 May 2017). * The programme fee includes accommodation for the duration of the program, field trips, workshops, entrance fees, working locations, supervision, some meals and the fee for Amsterdam International Water Week (AIWW) only inauguration session and for the Wetskills finals and awarding sessions. *Note: Participants can also register separately as Young Water Professional for the full conference programme of AIWW (this is not included in the Wetskills participation fee).*
- He/she is responsible for his/her own travel expenses (plane tickets, train, bus, etc.) and all other costs are not included in the program fee.

N.B. The Wetskills organisation is striving to find possibilities to keep the costs for participants at a minimum. During past editions participants often successfully arranged financial compensation for their Wetskills participation from their university or employer. We therefore strongly encourage applicants to inquire about funding opportunities to compensate the costs (university mobility funds, travel allowance etc.).

- Till the final deadline of this Wetskills event, he/she can refuse participation by sending the organisation e-mail.
- A cancellation after the deadline, but two months before the start of the Wetskills programme, he/she will pay 25% of the participation fee to the organisation.
- A cancellation between one and two months before the start of the Wetskills programme, he/she will pay 50% of the participation fee to the organisation.
- A cancellation within a month before the start of the Wetskills programme, he/she will pay 100% of the participation fee to the organisation.
- He/she bears full responsibility for own behaviour and the risks of the program. He/she acknowledges that the organisation and its partners are not responsible for any damage to personal belongings during participation in the program.
