# Join the fourth homecoming edition of Wetskills Water Challenges across the Dutch delta!

#### A new way to educational & networking approach for young professionals and students in the global water sector

The Wetskills programme focuses on out-of-the-box solutions for local water challenges by bringing teams of diverse international students and young professionals together.

#### Wetskills Water Challenges

The Wetskills Water Challenge is a two-week event for university level students and young water professionals from around the globe. Participants work in multidisciplinary and intercultural teams to develop out-of-the-box solutions for water challenges posed by case sponsors.

Since 2010, more than 500 students and young water professionals from about 100 international universities and organizations have participated in one of the 25 Wetskills Water Challenges held in Asia (China, Taiwan, Indonesia and India), North Africa & Middle East (Iran, Oman, Morocco, Israel and Egypt), Sub-Saharan Africa (South Africa & Mozambique), Europe (Romania, United Kingdom & the Netherlands) and North America (United States & Canada).

#### 19 October- 2 November 2017

In October/November 2017 a Wetskills Water Challenge will be hosted in The Netherlands for the fourth time. The non-profit Wetskills Foundation (based in The Netherlands) will be the organisator of this event.

The creative and collaborative spirit flows through out multidisciplinary teams, with the wide experience in natural sciences and engineering, as well as on social, economic and political sciences, in policy and business management. We hope you will join us to be part of this Wetskills experience in 2017!

This Wetskills edition will present the results of the teams during the fourth Amsterdam International Water Week (30 Oct – 3 Nov 2017).

Wetskills will formally start on 19 October 2017 with an opening event hosted at Waternet in Amsterdam. After this a tour in the Dutch delta will follow. Heerhugowaard, Leeuwarden, Zwolle, Wageningen, Utrecht, and Delft Will be visited with various site visits and the local expertise of the areas will asked to share with the Wetskills participants. After six days the teams will stay in Rotterdam to work on the cases.

The results will be presented in Amsterdam. Each team will pitch its solution at the end of the (two-week) challenge during a pitch session at the 4<sup>th</sup> Amsterdam International Water Week. The participants' presentations will contribute to the theme of the conference on 'Circular economy in urban deltas' by providing innovative and interdisciplinary solutions in an interactive pitch and poster session.
