



Terms & Conditions

Wetskills-South Korea 2018

The participant declares by registration that:

- He/she is able to attend the Wetskills Water Challenge programme in South Korea during the period of 28 January to 13 February 2018.
- He/she is able to pay the programme fee of maximum:
 - *€ 525.- for Dutch and international participants and South Korean participants without accommodation in Seoul
 - **€ 150.- for South Korean students that already have accommodation in Seoul

The programme fee includes: accommodation in Donghae for three nights (9-12 February), transportation from Seoul to Olympic area and back, field trips, workshops, working locations, supervision, some meals and the finals and awarding ceremony in Holand Heineken House. *Accommodation included at Hongik University in Seoul for the duration of the program.

- He/she is responsible for his/her own travel expenses (plain tickets, train, bus, etc.) and all other costs not included in the program fee.

N.B. The Wetskills organisation is striving to find possibilities to keep the costs to the participants at a minimum. During past editions participants often successfully arranged financial compensation for their Wetskills participation from their university or employer. We therefore strongly encourage applicants to inquire about funding opportunities to compensate the costs (university mobility funds, travel allowance etc.).

- Till the final deadline of this Wetskills event, he/she can refuse the participation by sending the organisation e-mail.
- A cancellation after the deadline, but two months before the start of the Wetskills programme, he/she will pay 25% of the participation fee to the organisation.
- A cancellation between one and two months before the start of the Wetskills programme, he/she will pay 50% of the participation fee to the organisation.
- A cancellation within a month before the start of the Wetskills programme, he/she will pay 100% of the participation fee to the organisation.
- He/she bears full responsibility for own behaviour and the risks of the program. He/she acknowledges that the organisation and its partners are not responsible for any damage to personal belongings during participation in the program.
