Qualification requirements

Qualifying organizations are based in Europe and include water organizations, water-related companies, knowledge institutes, (central, regional and local) government administrations, utilities and NGOs. Qualifying junior professionals have 2 to 8 years of work experience, are under the age of 35, and are available at least one day a week for a period of two years for training and project activities.
