



Terms & Conditions

Wetskills-United Kingdom 2017

The participant declares by registration that:

- He/she is able to attend the Wetskills Water Challenge programme in Bath, United Kingdom during the period of 30 March to 12 April 2017.
- He/she is able to pay the programme fee of maximum *£ 440,- (or *£ 415,- for early bird registration before 15 December 2016). *This fee is for participants without accommodation in Bath. The programme fee includes accommodation for the duration of the program, field trips, workshops, entrance fees, working locations, supervision and some meals.
- The pay programme fee for Bath residences is maximum **£ 240,- (or **£ 215,- for early bird registration before 15 December 2016). **This programme fee excludes accommodation for the duration of the program.
- He/she is responsible for his/her own travel expenses (plain tickets, train, bus, etc) and all other costs not included in the program fee.

N.B. The Wetskills organisation is striving to find possibilities to keep the costs to the participants at a minimum. During past editions participants often successfully arranged financial compensation for their Wetskills participation from their university or employer. We therefore strongly encourage applicants to inquire about funding opportunities to compensate the costs (university mobility funds, travel allowance etc.).

- Till the final deadline of this Wetskills event, he/she can refuse the participation by sending the organisation e-mail.
- A cancellation after the deadline, but two months before the start of the Wetskills programme, he/she will pay 25% of the participation fee to the organisation.
- A cancellation between one and two months before the start of the Wetskills programme, he/she will pay 50% of the participation fee to the organisation.
- A cancellation within a month before the start of the Wetskills programme, he/she will pay 100% of the participation fee to the organisation.
- He/she bears full responsibility for own behaviour and the risks of the program. He/she acknowledges that the organisation and its partners are not responsible for any damage to personal belongings during participation in the program.
