



# Terms & Conditions

Wetskills-Bangladesh 2019

## The participant declares by registration that:

- He/she is able to attend the Wetskills Water Challenge programme in Bangladesh (Dhaka and Sirajganj) during the period of 30 June to 12 July 2019.
- He/she is able to pay the programme fee of maximum:
  - Local participants: travel, local transport, daily costs (no participation costs)
  - International participants: travel, local transport, daily costs and a participation fee of € 150,- (excl. 21% VAT)

The programme fee includes: field trips, accommodation in Sirajganj, social activities, workshops, working locations, supervision, some of the meals and the Finals and Awarding ceremony.

- He/she is responsible to arrange his/her own travel (plain tickets, train, bus, etc.) and all other costs not included in the program fee.

*N.B. The Wetskills organisation is striving to find possibilities to keep the costs to the participants at a minimum. During past editions participants often successfully arranged financial compensation for their Wetskills participation from their university or employer. We therefore strongly encourage applicants to inquire about funding opportunities to compensate the costs (university mobility funds, travel allowance etc.).*

- Till two days after the acceptance email for this Wetskills event, he/she can refuse the participation by sending the organisation e-mail within two days.
- A cancellation after the acceptance letter, but one month before the start of the Wetskills programme, he/she will pay 25% of the participation fee to the organisation.
- A cancellation between one month and two weeks before the start of the Wetskills programme, he/she will pay 50% of the participation fee to the organisation.
- A cancellation within two weeks before the start of the Wetskills programme, he/she will pay 100% of the participation fee to the organisation.
- He/she bears full responsibility for own behaviour and the risks of the program. He/she acknowledges that the organisation and its partners are not responsible for any damage to personal belongings during participation in the program.
