

## Terms & Conditions Wetskills-Ghana 2025

## The participant, upon registration, affirms that:

- They commit to attending the Wetskills Water Challenge program in Accra, Ghana, scheduled from January 29 to February 12, 2025.
- They acknowledge the program fee, which is a maximum of €435 (excluding VAT, with VAT applicable only for participants from The Netherlands). This fee applies to international and local participants requiring accommodation in Durban during the program. The programme fee includes accommodation (hostel, sharing rooms with more participants), field trips, workshops, working locations, supervision, and some meals.
- They acknowledge personal responsibility for covering travel expenses (including plane tickets, train fare, bus transportation, etc.) and any additional costs not encompassed by the program fee. N.B. The Wetskills organisation strives to find ways to keep the costs to the participants as low as possible. During past editions, participants often successfully arranged financial compensation from their university or employer for their Wetskills participation. We therefore strongly encourage applicants to inquire from local and regional institutions about funding opportunities to compensate for the costs (mobility funds, travel allowance, etc.).

## • Cancellation procedure

- Until the final registration deadline for this Wetskills event and **three days** after the Acceptance email, participants can refuse participation by sending an email to the organisation.
- If you cancel within **three days** of receiving the acceptance email but two months before the start of the Wetskills programme, you will pay the organisation 25% of the participation fee.
- Cancellation is between one and two months before the start of the Wetskills programme, and they will pay 50% of the participation fee to the organisation.
- If you cancel within a month before the start of the Wetskills programme, you will be required to pay 100% of the participation fee to the organisation.
- If the travel regulations between countries change due to the coronavirus (COVID-19) between the acceptance email and the programme's start, the participants will receive the participation fee back. Wetskills Foundation and its partners will not be responsible for compensation for costs such as travel tickets, quarantine time, or repatriation flights.
- They bear full responsibility for their behaviour and the risks of the program. They acknowledge that the organisation and its partners are not responsible for any loss of, or damage to, personal belongings during participation in the program.
- They bear full responsibility for dealing with the coronavirus (COVID-19) according to the
  regulations and directions of the WHO, the Ghana and Dutch governments, and their country of
  residence. Wetskills Foundation and its partners will not be responsible for compensation for costs
  such as travel tickets, quarantine time, or repatriation flights. Only participation fees will be
  recovered (see also cancellation procedures).
- Before, during and after the Wetskills programme, the Wetskills Foundation will treat the personal data according to the AGV regulations in The Netherlands, based on the E.U's General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).
